# Playbook: Using Bing Image Creator for Character Development

### **Objective:**

This playbook will guide you, Trailblazers, on how to use **Bing Image Creator** to bring your characters to life for the AI Writers Guild. With your **Microsoft A3 licenses**, you'll have extra capabilities to create consistent, high-quality images while exploring different art styles. You'll also learn how to set a **seed** to keep your character's look consistent across multiple images.

## **Step 1: Accessing Bing Image Creator**

## 1. Open Bing in your browser

o Go to Bing Image Creator or access it via the Bing search engine.

# 2. Sign in with Microsoft

Log in using your Microsoft account linked to your A3 license. This grants you
more free image generations and greater flexibility than basic accounts.

## **Step 2: Choosing Your Art Style**

You have a variety of art styles to choose from in Bing Image Creator. Here's a guide to some popular styles and what they offer:

#### 1. Realism

- o **Description**: Detailed and lifelike, perfect for creating characters that look like they belong in the real world.
- o **Use for**: Characters in modern or historical settings where realism is essential.

#### 2. Fantasy

- o **Description**: Magical, otherworldly style with vivid colors, mystical elements, and surreal details.
- o Use for: Characters in mythical, fantasy, or sci-fi worlds.

#### 3. Anime

- Description: Based on the stylized, exaggerated features of Japanese animation.
   Think large eyes, expressive emotions, and bold lines.
- Use for: High-energy or stylized characters, particularly in futuristic or adventure-based stories.

#### 4. Cartoon

- o **Description**: Simple, exaggerated features with a playful or humorous tone.
- o Use for: Lighthearted characters or comedic stories.

### 5. Steampunk

- Description: A retro-futuristic style that blends Victorian elements with steampowered technology.
- Use for: Characters in alternative historical settings or futuristic adventures.

#### 6. Noir

- o **Description**: Dark, shadow-heavy art with high contrast. Characters have a mysterious, film-noir feel.
- o Use for: Detective stories or moody, atmospheric character development.

#### 7. Abstract

- o **Description**: Highly creative and interpretive, focusing more on color and form than realism.
- o Use for: Characters in dreamlike, surreal settings.

### 8. Impressionism

- o **Description**: Soft brushstrokes and light to create an atmospheric effect, capturing the "impression" rather than fine details.
- o **Use for**: Characters in soft, natural, or historical settings.

#### 9. Comic Book

- Description: Bold lines, strong color contrasts, and dynamic poses reminiscent of superhero comics.
- o Use for: Action-driven characters or stories with dramatic conflict.

## Tips:

• Be sure to **include your chosen art style** in the prompt. For example: "A teenage detective in anime style with curly brown hair..."

# **Step 3: Crafting a Strong Prompt**

Use this template to incorporate the art style into your prompt:

## • Basic Prompt Template:

"A [describe your character's role, e.g., young warrior, teenage detective, etc.] with [hair color], [eye color], wearing [clothing style], drawn in [art style]. They are standing in [setting, e.g., forest, city, classroom] and have a [expression, e.g., serious, happy, thoughtful] look."

### • Example:

"A teenage detective with curly brown hair, bright blue eyes, wearing a hoodie and jeans, drawn in anime style. They are standing in a dimly lit city alley, looking curious and focused."

## • Setting a Seed for Consistency:

- To make sure your character looks the same across multiple images, you'll need to set a seed. After generating an image you like, look for the seed number (usually found in the metadata or advanced options).
- o Include the **seed number** in your prompt to recreate the same character:
  - **Example**: "A teenage detective with curly brown hair and bright blue eyes, drawn in anime style, seed: 123456789."

### • Tips to add to your prompt:

o Add the words, "on a solid white background".

- Write about the noun you're depicting, then add "in the style of anime" to the end. Then change just the style words to alter the graphic of the noun.
  - A medieval castle, in the style of anime
  - A medieval castle, in the style of **steampunk**
  - A medieval castle, in the style of **realism**

This ensures your character's features remain consistent when you generate new poses or settings for them.

# **Step 4: Generating and Downloading Your Image**

### 1. Type Your Prompt

 Enter your character's description in the text box. Click "Create" to generate the image.

## 2. Review and Adjust

o Bing Image Creator will generate a few options. If you set a seed, the character should remain consistent. Review the images and tweak the prompt if needed.

### 3. Download Your Image

 Once satisfied with the result, click on the image to enlarge it, then download it to your device.

## 4. Bonus with Your A3 License

o Your **A3 license** provides more free image generations, so don't hesitate to experiment with different art styles or settings until your character is just right!

# **Step 5: Refining Your Character**

Use the image you generated to update your character's profile:

- **Update your OneNote Notebook**: Refine any new details about your character's appearance, behavior, or backstory based on the image.
- Character Consistency: Thanks to the seed feature, your character will remain visually consistent across multiple images. This helps with continuity in your story.

# **Step 6: Sharing with the Guild**

Once you've developed your character's image:

- 1. Upload the image to the AI Writers Guild Engage app.
- 2. Write a brief description: Include the original prompt, the art style you chose, and any thoughts on how the image shaped or refined your character's development.

3. **Engage in peer feedback**: Check out your peers' creations in the Engage app, provide constructive feedback, and get inspired by each other's work.

# **Optional Challenges**

- **Create alternate versions**: Generate your character in multiple art styles (e.g., anime, realism, steampunk) to explore different creative approaches.
- **Visualize supporting characters**: Use Bing Image Creator to develop images for side characters or antagonists in the same style.
- Create a group shot: Generate an image featuring multiple characters to visualize your cast together.
